ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS OF GLENSIDE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2020

WHEREAS, the Board of Library Trustees for the Glenside Public Library District, DuPage County, Illinois, caused to be prepared in tentative form a Budget and the Secretary of this Board has made the same conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as to such Budget on the 22nd day of August, 2019, and notice of said hearing was given at least thirty (30) days prior thereto as required by law, and all other legal requirements have been complied with.
